

## Data Collection: How it helps your clinic

- Baseline Surveys: Provides a snap shot of your clinic and adaptive reserve before the intervention and helps develop the Practice Improvement Plan (PIP) and Data Quality Improvement Plan (DQIP)
- 9-Month Surveys: Identifies changes that took place from the start of the 9 month of QI and data support
- 15 Month Surveys: Identifies the retention and continuation of and CVD QI after the facilitation ends
- CQMs are gathered at each of the three time points and periodically throughout the 9 months of intervention






